Kolacky are a national Czech pastry. There were a lot of Czech immigrants that emigrated to the Berwyn and Cicero areas of Illinois back in the day- which consumed many kolacky and passed the tradition down to their families."

"Every Christmas, my mom will make a holiday punch with cranberry juice, grapefruit soda and sherbet. It is delectable—sweet, citrus, red berry and floral and has huge globs of sherbet sitting on top! Over the years, the recipe has evolved depending on availability of ingredients. Sometimes the citrus soda changes, sometimes the cranberry juice is replaced with a cran-raspberry option and sometimes we make it a little more adult-friendly and add a splash or two of prosecco. The flavor I made is my interpretation of what this punch tastes like in more recent years. It's sweet, fruity, decadent, creamy and a crowd favorite."
