90% of consumers said they find food and beverage products with ingredients specific to the season very appealing.

91% said they find seasonal flavors exciting because they can't always get this particular flavor.

Berry flavors were #6 in overall liking of seasonal flavors. Strawberry shortcake, blueberry muffin, mixed berry and raspberry flavor concepts all had a mean score of 4.25 (5 point scale, 5= extremely interested) of specific berry flavors.
